I. Call Meeting to Order

The Haviland City Council met in special session with Mayor Robert Ellis calling the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Linda Simmons opened the meeting with prayer. John Unruh mentioned a complaint that has not been followed up on regarding dogs. The Council discussed this and decided that Mike Gurnee will no longer be the code enforcement officer. McAfee will place an ad in the Pratt Tribune and Kiowa County Signal advertising for a part-time code and animal public officer.
